Here are some specific issues we will be begin discussing at the roundtable:

- Delegate/member communications methods presently in use in our area

- Considering which Delegate/member communications may no longer be needed

I am envisioning the roundtable as a first step in launching a more in-depth study that could lead to a communications workgroup with members from all levels of the triangle similar to the one the board has established. With that in mind, I'm hoping as many members as possible will participate on Oct. 1.
